MEMORANDUM

Use of MicroPro Sienna Treated Wood in Direct Contact with Fresh Water

Due to the unique characteristics of MicroPro® wood preservative technology, MicroPro Sienna™ Treated Wood can be used in direct contact with fresh water for use in docks and other structures. The Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) of Health Canada has thoroughly reviewed the environmental performance of MicroPro treated wood and concluded that it can be used in direct contact with fresh water.

The PMRA is responsible for overseeing the registration of all wood preservatives in Canada. Before wood preservatives are registered for use, they are thoroughly reviewed and are subject to a public review process. MicroPro 200C-TS was fully registered with the PMRA in August 2011 and is the only copper-based wood preservative approved for direct contact with fresh water.

PMRA has registered MicroPro 200C-TS (Reg. #30196) for the following applications:

“For use as a wood preservative in the treatment of wood products for above ground, ground contact and fresh water contact uses such as lumber, timbers, landscape ties, fence boards, and posts, building poles and decks, docks, walkways, and wood shingles.”
